New Club OC6 Trailer

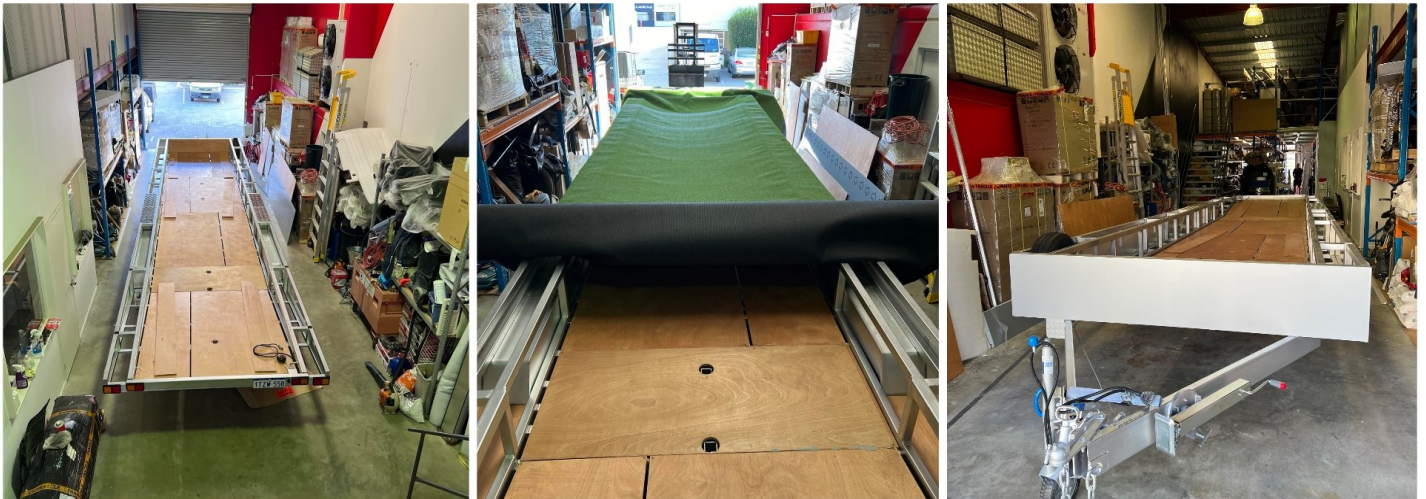
Thanks to our major sponsor "JOHOR1" the club had a new OC6 trailer built.
