Health and Safety Policy

Hurricane Outrigger Canoe Club is firmly committed to a policy enabling all sporting activities to be carried out safely, and with all possible measures taken to remove (or at least reduce to As Low As Reasonably Practical) risks to the health, safety and welfare of club members, volunteers, club visitors, and anyone else who may be affected by our activities.

We are committed to ensuring we comply with related work health and safety legislation, regulations, marine legislation, applicable Codes of Practice, WA Zone AOCRA (WAZA) and the Australian Outrigger Canoe Racing Association (AOCRA) requirements.

Hurricane Outrigger Canoe Club will strive to continually improve our club procedures and processes. This will be done by monitoring sporting activities and implementing changes and control measures to create a safe and welcoming environment.

In support of this policy, the club accepts its responsibility for the prevention of incidents through identification, assessment and elimination of hazards where reasonably practicable and within the club's control and authority.

Club members will be consulted and encouraged to participate in matters which affect their health and safety and in observing and recommending changes to reduce exposure to any identified hazards and risks.

Hurricane Outrigger Canoe Club expect all its club members to accept responsibility for their actions, to report unsafe acts and conditions, to actively participate in improvement processes and behave in a manner that reflects safe practices and standards both on the water, at sporting events and in use of club facilities.

This policy will be reviewed on a regular basis and when legislative or governing authority change occurs that may impact on health and safety considerations for the club.
